Jesus the Lamb

John 1:35-37

In Ephesians 1:23, Paul says that Jesus “fills everything in every way.” He is all-sufficient and meets every need. So perfect and complete is Jesus that He is not only the Shepherd but the Lamb as well! John saw a vision of heaven’s multitudes magnifying Jesus, singing, “_____ is the Lamb that was slain to receive POWER, and RICHES, and WISDOM, and STRENGTH, and HONOR, and GLORY, and BLESSING!!!” (Revelation 5:12).

The Lamb FEEDS!

Revelation 7:17 tells us that Jesus the Lamb is our source for _____. When we look back at the Passover story in Exodus 12, we often overlook the fact that when each Israelite family slew its lamb, they were to eat of its meat. The same sacrifice that saved their sons also fueled their flight from Egypt!

The Lamb LEADS!

Usually you think of the lamb _____ led, not _____ the leading, but Jesus filleth all in all! Revelation 7:17 says He will guide the saints to living springs of water. As sheep ourselves, we need direction in the ways of meekness and humility – and there is no one better to lead us than the Lamb of God (Matthew 11:29).

The Lamb BLEEDS!

The Lamb shed His blood, and in doing so poured out His _____ (Leviticus 17:11) so that we could live. The Lamb takes away the sins of the world by taking those sins on Himself and bearing them to the cross and to the grave. In giving Himself to be slain, the Lamb of God offered up His PRECIOUS (I Peter 1:19), PURIFYING (Revelation 7:14), POWERFUL blood (Revelation 12:11).
