## Jesus the Way

*John 14:1-6*

### *The Problem*

*The disciples were about to be devastated! Already Jesus was leading up to the shocking events of His death with some disturbing predictions of betrayal and denial. He was talking of leaving them behind, and their whole world was starting to unwind. They were about to go through a time of doubt, depression and distress. Their Shepherd was going to be smitten and they His sheep would be scattered (**Matthew 26:31**). The Lord tells them not to let their hearts be troubled even in these troubling circumstances. ### *The Promise*

*Jesus wanted their eyes on the prize.
