## Jesus the Omega

*Revelation 1:7-8*

*Jesus introduces Himself not only as Alpha, the Beginning, but also as Omega, the Ending. This last letter of the Greek alphabet shows the finality of Jesus as the ending point of all there is. Everything leads to Him and every soul will end up standing before His judgment seat when all is said and done. He is the Climax, the Culmination of all. He is the first and last and everything in between; Jesus is all in all!*

### *He's the FULFILLMENT of the plan*

*Romans 10:4* says that Christ is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the law. Every sign and symbol pointed the way to Jesus and His death marked the completion of the redemptive work of God on man's behalf.
