Jesus the Son

Hebrews 1:1-4

*In **John 14:8**, Philip said to Jesus, “All we want is for you to show us the Father!” The Lord’s reply was that whoever had seen Him had already seen the Father. The beauty of knowing Jesus is that, since He is the “spitting image” of the heavenly Father, if you know the Son, you automatically know the Father. When you see the Son, you see...*

the Father’s P_____

*It’s easy to see the Father as a distant or domineering figure who doesn’t have the time or the tolerance to deal with children. But the Son says, “Let the little children come to me!” (**Matthew 19:13-14**) and in doing so, He demonstrates the nature of an _____-God who looks with love on the weak and lowly and longs for us to be in His presence. He shows us that we are not an inconvenience to the Father but rather His pride and joy.*

the Father’s P_____

*Jesus came to reveal a God who takes no delight in withholding blessings from His children. Read **Matthew 15:29-39**. The Son shows the compassion of the Father for our hardship and affliction, and the Son’s actions remind us that the Father always provides for His children (**Psalms 37:25**).*

the Father’s P_____

*The Hebrew writer tells us that the Son is the exact image of the Father’s very being. They are one in nature and essence, and it is the Son who shows us exactly what the Father is all about. **I John 4:16** reminds us that God ___ love, and the ultimate expression of that love is made manifest in the coming of Jesus to live with us and to die for us.*
