John 6:48-51

The SOURCE is significant!

He is that Bread that came down from _____. The wilderness of Sin (*Exodus 16*) represents the time of testing between your _____ deliverance and your _____ deliverance. Understand that without some divine assistance, **some God-sent help from on high**, you and I would die in the desert, wandering and wasting away! We need some help from heaven to make it home, and Jesus is that spiritual Manna. The r_____ will get a lot of us in trouble, and the r_____ will be the downfall of others (*Num. 11:4*), but those who can satisfy themselves with the Bread of heaven will live to see the Promised Land.

The SUBSTANCE is significant!

It is important to note that Jesus doesn't just say, "I **give** you bread," but that He says, "I _____ that Bread!" By becoming our food Himself, the Lord is letting us know that He desires an intensely personal fellowship with each of us. If we are not careful we will strive to survive on food of lesser substance – and end up starving to death spiritually. Even _____ will leave you empty without the only food of real substance, and that is _____ (*John 6:28-29*).

The SUSTENANCE is significant!

Jesus qualifies Himself as the _____ Bread (*John 6:51*). That is important because you and I can't LIVE on a diet of _____ bread! Our Redeemer lives (*Revelation 1:18*), and because He lives, we have the nourishment we need to keep _____ (*Philippians 3:12-14*) and to keep _____ (*Ephesians 4:14-15*).
